Ensuring Accessibility for All: Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Self-Evaluation

To effectively evaluate our current accessibility practices, we have assembled a dedicated team representing various city departments, including public works, transportation, parks and recreation, and community services. During the self-evaluation process, we will assess the accessibility of city-owned buildings, facilities, and public spaces, ensuring they meet ADA standards. We will also evaluate our policies, procedures, and practices to identify any areas that require improvement, such as hiring practices, communication methods, and emergency preparedness.
