RE: SANITARY SEWER CONNECTION AT <ADDRESS>


Dear Mr. and Mrs. ,

The City of Seven Hills has advised the Cuyahoga County Board of Health that the sanitary sewer installed on your street is completed and is now ready to accept sanitary flow. It is our duty in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code Section 3701-29-06(I) under the authority vested in Ohio Revised Code Sections 3709.21 and 3718.10 to notify you to take the following actions within **six (6) months** of this notification:

1. Select a contractor.
2. Obtain a sewage treatment system abandonment permit from the Cuyahoga County Board of Health.
3. Secure a sewer connection permit from the Seven Hills Building Department.
4. Complete the sanitary sewer connection and arrange for an inspection with Seven Hills.
4. Properly abandon your existing household sewage treatment system (HSTS), and arrange for an abandonment inspection with our office. All tanks must be pumped, crushed, and backfilled. An abandonment fact sheet and permit application are included.
