ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AVAILABILITY NOTICE

The Ohio EPA, through the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) program, is considering funding a project which is subject to environmental review requirements. The proposed project consists of extending sanitary sewer lines to residences of the West Creek Phases II and III project area in the City of Seven Hills, and eliminating the unsanitary conditions found there.

As Ohio EPA will be issuing a Draft Finding of No Significant Impact and an accompanying Environmental Assessment (EA) on this project in the near future, this notice is to advise the public that it will have a 30-day period in which to review the EA and provide comments to the Ohio EPA contact named at the back of the document. This public comment period will begin with the release of the document to the public through the City of Seven Hills' web site, Ohio EPA's web site, and mailing of the document to a randomly selected group of residents.
